BLACK HERITAGE PARADE CRITERIA

- 1. All participants are expected to perform courteously, in good taste, and with safety in mind at all times during the assembly, execution, and dispersal of the parade.
- 2. Music: No profane language is not allowed. The police will escort you out.
- 3. Children participating in the parade under the age of twelve (except those in a marching unit) must be on a float.
- 4. Floats: Decor should cover the tires and must have at least 2 adults walking on each side.
- 5. Marching units: You must have a banner (*Each marching unit will be allowed 1 chaperone per 10 unit members.*)
- 6. Walkers: Orange safety/reflector vests are required for ALL walkers. Vest can be purchased at parade check-in. Vest are 2/\$5.00
- 7. Candy: Do not place it in the spectator's hands! All candies thrown must be tossed to spectators over 4 feet away.
- 8. Tires: Burning rubber and rapid acceleration while sitting still are strictly prohibited.
- 9. ALL Cars/Vans/Trucks will be inspected for the following:
 - a. Cleanliness
 - b. Minimum of 2 posters with theme and organization name. Writing must be neat and visible to the parade spectators.
 - c. Entry you registered has to be in the parade.

This criteria will allow us to provide everyone with the best parade experience possible.
